On Prayer 51 Watch and Pray (Part three)

If your mouth confession and your heart confession is that Jesus is your Lord, yet you don't have time for him, you are being hypocritical. Do you have an hour for the newspaper, or the television? Do you have an hour for Jesus?

If you can't set aside an hour for God, can you give him 15 minutes? Gradually increase it to 20 minutes, then 30 minutes, then bring it up to an hour. Do something every day. Never take a vacation from God. If you are too busy for God, you are too busy.

I used to believe that Martin Luther was exaggerating when he wrote, "When I have an extremely busy day, I get up and spend an extra hour in prayer." My life was so far removed from such a commitment that I could not even conceive of it.

The busier you are, the more necessary it is to pray. In fact, if you have that time alone with God, you will get twice as much done. This is true for anything – studying, making phone calls, doing housework – anything. Things go better with prayer. It is a delight, not a tedious duty.

We don't usually notice that Paul concludes his discussion of the armor of God in Eph 6 by encouraging prayer. Verse 18 tells us to, "always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints." Praying how often? "Always" With what? "Perseverance and supplication in the Spirit" And how attentive should our prayer be? "Watchful."

It won't do an army any good to have tanks, missiles, or airplanes if they have lost communication with their commander. The key to any army is communication. Weapons have to be triggered and armor has to be mobilized.

Prayer is our last and most important piece of armor. It provides communication with our commander in Chief and gives us direction. Prayer mobilizes.

If the rapture truly precedes the tribulations period (I am not convinced that it does, but it may), then we must watch and pray so that we can escape the tribulation period. Luke 21:34-36 says, "But take heed to yourselves, lest your hearts be weighed down with carousing, drunkenness, and cares of this life, and that day come on you unexpectedly. For it will come as a snare on all those who dwell on the face of the whole earth. Watch therefore, and pray always that you may be counted worthy [strong enough] to escape all these things that will come to pass, and to stand before the Son of Man." Many people say that the teaching of a rapture is escapism, but who is teaching an 'escape?' Jesus is teaching escape. Who escapes? Those who watch and pray. Mark 13:33-37 says, "Take heed, watch and pray; for you do not know when the time is. It is like a man going to a far country, who left his house and gave authority to his servants, and to each his work, and commanded the door keeper to watch. Watch therefore, for you do not know when the master of the house is coming – in the evening, at midnight, at the crowing of the rooster, or in the morning – lest coming suddenly, he find you sleeping. And what I say to you, I say to all: Watch!"

Four times in that one paragraph Jesus says to watch. He says we don't know when he is coming. Regardless of whether a person believes in a pre, mid, or post-tribulation rapture, the issue is watching, not attempting to date when it will occur. If you are asleep in sin, it won't make any difference when it happens. You see being able to predict it defeats the purpose. We must be ready.

A Hadith is a book in a library of books (Plural ahadith) that are a compilation of the traditions and legends of Muhammed, put together after his death. Hadith 8, 73:224 – Muffhun, narrated Abu Huraira, apostle of Allah:

"The most awful name in Allah's sight on the day of resurrection will be that of a man calling himself "MALIK AL-AMLAK" (MEANING THE KING OF KINGS)

Revelation 17:14, "These shall make war with the Lamb (MEANING JESUS), and the Lamb shall overcome them: for he is Lord of lords, and KING OF KINGS; and they that are with him are called, and chosen, and faithful" / Revelation 19:14-16, "And the armies in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed him on white horses. Now out of his mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it he should strike the nations. And he himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. And he has on his robe and on his thigh a name written: King of Kings and Lord of Lords." 1 Timothy 6:14-15, "Keep this commandment without spot, blameless until our Lord Jesus Christ's appearing, which he will manifest in his own time, who is the blessed and only potentate, the King of kings and Lord of lords."

Quran, Surah 3:54, "They planned to deceive, and Allah planned to deceive, and Allah is the Greatest of all deceivers." 8:30, "They plotted deception, but Allah also plotted deception, and Allah is the best of deceivers."

Revelation 12:9, "That serpent of old, called the Devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world"

Quran, Surah 59:23, "Allah is the most proud" Isaiah 14:12-15/Ezekiel 28:11-19 "Satan was cast out of Heaven because of his pride" Quran, Surah 3:156, 7:158, 15:23, 57:2 "Allah is the DESTROYER"

All you have to do to lose a spiritual battle is to simply do nothing. This is the way that Satan defeats many of our generation today – by dulling them through drugs, addictions, and with their phones. The world's devices can actually allude to the enemy's perception of a situation. His perception will help determine the weapon he chooses from his arsenal. The lack of resistance or the lack of will to fight back using the word and prayer can actually lengthen the amount of time given to the enemy to battle for your soul.

In order to be able to discern the spirit realm, it is important that you understand what a real Christian is. There are some ways to identify a real, born-again, redeemed believer, who has been forgiven of his or her sins and cleansed through the redemptive blood of Christ. First, there will be spiritual fruit of the vine in that person's life (John 15:8). Once a real follower of Christ becomes an active Christian after receiving initial redemption, then "Old things have passed away, behold all things have become new" (II Cor 5:17). Paul said we become a new creation. We all have the potential for sinning, but when our determination for right is stronger than our desire for wrong, then we defeat the devil. We must renew our mind daily, and we must be renewed from the fiery darts that are carnal, and the negative thoughts from the enemy. This is how Satan works in our minds from images and things we know better than to look at (Eph 6:16)

Christ gave his followers authority over all the power of the enemy (Luke 10:19). No matter what, and in any situation, light always shines in a dark place. It always overpowers darkness. We are children of light and we overpower darkness through Christ (Eph 5:8). Without a doubt, one of the main game plans in the playbook of Satan is to place an individual under the bondage of pornography, which, for a believer, will produce condemnation, guilt, and shame, thus the spiritual walk, confidence, and prayer life become compromised. We must not allow condemnation to take over. Forgiveness is the best counter attack.

Crucifixion Night was like a double-edged sword: it was heavy on the hearts of the people at Real Identity because they knew that Jesus was going to be crucified and were grief-stricken, yet it was a joy and a celebration of what he accomplished. Hearts leapt because of the price he paid for every single person in AD first century and those in many upcoming Generations. So it was like a two-edged sword of grief and freedom because of his love for us.

Pastor Matt said, "Our sin is what put him there and false witnesses came forth but Jesus held his peace. Just as Jesus did, we must stay focused when we hear from him so that everything will be established and his timing and his plans and purpose for our life will come to fruition. Religion had to die so Grace could live. We've all experienced before-and-after, but that's where the enemy will try to come in and burden us. Not always put up with men. Being an evangelist is good because I preach and then I'm gone. I don't have to come back the next day for people to stone me. Quit sitting in the stands and get into the arena. If you are in the arena and call to the people in the stands, 'I need help,' They will say, 'I'm praying for you.' Pull them down into the arena.

"The seducing spirit says, 'Tell them you don't have time to be saved.' God says, 'Behold, now is the time of salvation.' After sanctification, we move into service. Too many stay in the sanctification phase only. They are not into service. They die and go to hell. Move into service. Pastors, make evangelism a priority. Eddie Cook led three people to Christ this week alone. You cannot get away with sin. There are consequences for sin.

Body of Christ, you better start getting along with each other and stop looking at each other's faults. If you see a clique in your church, destroy it. It does not belong in church. To have friends, you must show yourself friendly.

"The world is not seeing the people in the church doing what they are supposed to do. We must leave here and make a difference. The only thing you can take with you to heaven is someone else. The seducing spirit says, 'There's no hope for them. They're poor, unattractive, sinful. There's no hope.' We must be **doers** of the word **now**, not next week. The devil is stealing your time.

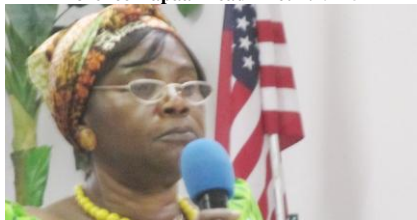

him a license, to which John Wesley answered, 'The world is my parish.' His immortal words are pregnant with the Spirit. When these young Ghanian men preached, they were told by the Anglicans to stop. They refused and were subsequently arrested and sent to prison, where they continued to preach. Therefore, many prisoners came out reformed and Christian. One

imprisoned young man told British ship captain Porter, 'When you get back to England, we

need Bibles.' When this young man was released from prison at 27, he walked all over Ghana and preached. We have preachers now with 4-wheel drive who won't do that. This man walked for days through the bush, where there are no hotels and thousands were saved. He only lived free and preaching for 6 months, but he preached the whole time for the souls perishing. The spirit of truth carried on. Those sent by God, he gave the willingness to serve him.

"What John 14:15 says is true. Jesus said, 'I am in the Father and the Father is in me.' We try to imitate Christ in what we do. We are human, but he does for us. Peter actually walked on water. Where was the gravity? The Lord suspended it for him. It is only when you turn your view to the world that you sink.

"Those men who preached in Ghana and died like flies, we are the fruit. The center of gravity of Christianity is in Africa, Asia, the Pacific Islands. Those who have called me primitive are now marrying men to men and women to women. We condemn this. Those countries that were called Christian counties and now devoid of Christians. The saying used to be that the sun never sets on the British Empire, and it was true. Now the sun has even set on Britain herself.

"Eph 4:7-11, in a church that is a living church, you will see these marks. God gave gifts to his church when Jesus ascended and led captivity captive. For the vacuum left in the church he sent apostles, those who are sent out. Peter said in Acts 2:38, to be saved and baptized, **then** you will receive gifts. Others were made prophets, who can **stand** and tell the truth, who can identify evil and expose it. There are evangelists, who can operate under harsh conditions, can sleep under a tree all night, get up and continue with God's mission. In a church where people can testify, they say 'I **met** Christ and he challenged me. Can you say this, or are you here to warm the seat? No one is born a Christian, not even in a Christian family; you must get it for yourself. I am not a minister because my father was a minister.

"Pastors and teachers don't teach so much with words and a blackboard, but with the way they live their lives. A journalist once said to Billy Graham, 'I have never seen you live in a way that was against what you say. Do you really believe those things?'" When Pastor Graham answered in the affirmative, the journalist resigned his journalist job and devoted his life to Christ.

"Acts 2:42, 'And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship...' If these people would not have met **daily**, they would never have learned scripture, because there was no Bible as we know it today. The Talmidim taught as Christ meant them to. They fellowshipped. It was not a men's fellowship or a women's fellowship, but real
