On Prayer 67

Persevering in Prayer

(Part Three)

Rom 12:12 exhorts us to rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer.

II Cor 4:1 also declares the importance of perseverance: "Therefore, since we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we do not lose heart."

"Losing heart" is a very graphic phrase. It could be translated as "losing excitement and enthusiasm, losing your heart's desire for something."

What "ministry" is Paul talking about? It could be preaching to thousands, leading a Bible study, or being a home group leader. In the previous verse, he says that, "with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory just as by the Spirit of the Lord" (II Cor 3:18).

The ministry Paul is talking about is ministering to God – beholding God's glory, being transparent, having a face that is not veiled, moving from one degree of glory to another, and looking to Yeshua. That is a bit different than ministering to people.

Ministering to Yeshua brings about a relationship. **You can solve any problem by concentrating on your relationship with God instead of focusing on the problem.** If the Lord is precious to you, and you are talking to him, you will hear his voice giving direction and encouragement. "They that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint" (Is 40:31 KJV).

Be like an eagle that soars on the wind of the wind of the storm instead of the sparrow, which is knocked down by the same storm. Instead of being **under** the circumstances, be **over** the circumstances.

Ministering to God feeds our inner man. "Therefore we do not lose heart. Even though our outward man is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day" (II Cor 4:16 NKJV). The real you is not your skin and hair or the shape of your nose, eyes, or mouth. The real you is the inner man who needs spiritual food, and that's where strength and perseverance come in. The inner man is renewed on a daily basis.

In Mat 17:20, we find one of the greatest verses on persevering in prayer. Jesus said to the 12 talmidim, "Assuredly I say to you, if you have faith of a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you."

While my husband and I were in Israel, we were in the garden tomb in Yerushalayim (Jerusalem) and the tour guide took some mustard seeds from a little plant and laid one in my hand. It was the smallest speck of a seed. Our faith is like that seed. Do you have enough faith to forgive that person who has hurt you and to love them instead of retaliating? Can you pray for them or fast one meal a day for them? Do you have enough faith to plant seeds of love? A tiny seed can move a great mountain.

We usually think of the verse that says, "Nothing shall be impossible for God." (see Luke 1:37.) But here Jesus challenges us. Nothing will be

impossible for **us** if we take that little speck of faith and plant it. We can all do that. If he had said our faith must be bigger than the mountain, we would be in defeated for sure. But he said the only thing we need is a speck of faith, and he said to plant it. Keep on planting seeds of love, faith, and prayer. Keep forgiving and putting your arm around people to encourage them. We look for something big to do, but the Lord says all we need is a tiny speck of icalmbecause it gives me something I can do. In this context, I can move a mountain.

Read Mat 17:20. Meditate on it, and try to memorize it. If you are discouraged about your problems or someone you love, this is your verse. Begin planting little seeds.

In January of 2018 I began a search for something more than what I already thought I had.

I have been in the habit of going to Belmont Baptist Church on Hwy 60 to read and pray. In February I got up in the morning to go there and things went differently than they normally do. As I drove, God changed the plan. He sent me on a 12-hour journey through the North Georgia Mountains. It was just him and me. He showed me quite a lot that day, but that was just the beginning of the journey.

The next time I went to my spot on the property of Belmont Baptist, I passed another property – one that I have passed hundreds of times – on my way home. It always has a little sign out front that says, "Praise and worship Friday Nights at 7pm." I knew who lived there, but I had no idea of what God had in store. I knew that I had to go there one Friday Night.

The week before Pesach (Passover), I woke up and told myself that I was going. That evening when I got off work, I went home, changed, got in my truck, and went to Unity on a Mission for the first time.

"What I saw when I arrived I did not expect. When I pulled in, I saw people that I knew. These were the same people I served with at Living Word (Jefferson Church). It was like Celebrate the Jewel (as Rock Shunk would say) all over again. I saw Rock, Sammy, Jo Jo, Bobby, Robert (Elwood), and many others.

In my mind I told myself, "Wow! This is where everyone has been the last five years. It was a full circle." Over the next several months I continued to come back.

God to use him; it is 17-year-old Maxine, who never seems able to sit still through the entire service because she is so bored hearing the same old thing. It is every one of us that is called.

We are called to do the work that is required to make sure that the lamb that was slain receives the reward of his suffering. What is this reward? The reward is you, and me, and the owner of the store across the street, and the woman with all the kids that lives three doors down from you. The reward is for the people who are not saved to become saved, for the Lord to come to know him. We are called for this – all of us.

We are called for something else as well. We are called to do the work that it takes to bring the whole body of Christ into one body, as the Bible tells us to. There are groups of Christians around the state, around the country and around the world that exist to do this very thing and they need **your** help because we are **all** called to do this. In John 17:20-21 Jesus himself prayed, "I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in me through their word; that they all may be one, as you, Father are n me, and I in you; that they may be one in us, that the world may believe that you sent me."

People, we need to stop acting as if the kingdom of God is all about **our** church and what **our** church is doing, as if we were the only ones headed to the kingdom.

Brother Rick Hempton told a story of what happened when his daughter asked Christ into her life. She went on a mission trip to Haiti just after the earthquake in 2010 because she spoke French. In the church compound where she was, a Voodoo temple was less than a mile away. When she could get none of the church people to go with her, she went alone to witness to the people there. She spoke to the Voodoo priest, who said, "All you Christians say something different. You should get yourselves together and then come back to talk to me." This is exactly what the world sees in us. Jesus prayed that we all be one, then he said why: so that the world will know that he was sent by the Father. The world can never know that as long as we stay this divided, especially in America.

Not only must we stop the sectarianism, not only must we get okay with those Christians that don't worship, or meet, or sing, or pray like we do, but we must come together and work for this unity we are told by the word of God that we are to have. It takes work to bring the body into one – hard work.

The harvest is ready, but the laborers are few. There is a group of churches in Barrow, Jackson, Hall, Walton, Gwinnett, Oconee, and Clarke Counties that exists to do this work. It is the **Whole Body of Christ Alliance**, the WBCA. There are other alliances as well, like **One People Ministries**, operating in Georgia, Ohio, Arizona, and Texas. In August 12,000 people gathered at Stone Mountain to move to bring the whole body together. We are not talking about ecumenicalism - everyone compromising their beliefs until we all believe the same thing. I am talking about being different and continuing to be different, but loving each other, staying close to each other, and celebrating our differences. I am not talking about one world religion. I am talking about coming together with our brothers and sisters because, if we don't do it, and do it **now**, we will not be able to survive in what is very quickly coming upon us.

If you have read this far in this article, you know that what I am saying is true. I urge you, I beseech you, to turn to page 7, get the information for contacting the Whole Body of Christ Alliance. If you are willing to work for the kingdom of God – I mean actually work, not just talk about it like most people do – turn some pages, make a call and do this work.

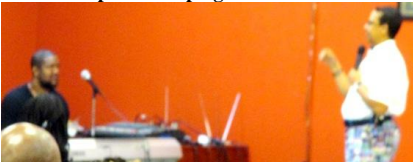

“Something happened when we were on the floor. Sometimes God does things in the low places. In

Genesis, God was creating. It was evening and then it was morning – the first day. In Levitical studies, evening represents what is revealed, and when it is revealed it is day. This is because in the day, people could've seen that it was not yet ready. God takes us to concealed places because sometimes things are not ready. A Jewish day begins in the evening. Gentiles only have 12 hours; we use all 24. The gentile day begins in the light and goes into the dark; the Jewish day begins in the dark and goes to the light. In God there is no time. You think you are as old as you are and God is running out of time. That is not possible; God does not exist in time. As it is in heaven, let it be on earth. We are transcending time.

“There are seven boxes – one week. I made them myself. Eternity is where all things exist and the Holy Spirit is the gatekeeper. We have a spiritual consciousness because our minds have been renewed. We think and see things now in spiritual terms. People think they understand the Holy Spirit into the reality of eternal life. They try to use their mind – their brain body – to get there, but the word says that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom. You cannot. The spirit is the master, the soul is the steward and the mind is the servant.

“Heb 1:2-4, salvation makes every born-again a living eternal. When is your eternal life? Right now! You have eternal life the moment you receive Messiah, at the moment of real salvation. You can be 100 years-old and still act the fool – know not faithfulness. I'm not talking about faith. You can believe in God for 30 years and still not be faithful. It is the Spirit of God that administers holiness because holiness is being set apart. Recognize the separateness of God. We try to make God subservient in our prayer time and you've not done anything because you pray and you don't even stay to listen. Mature sons understand nothing in their physical brain that can construct God outside of this.

“In this time, the church, the government of God, must become spiritual. You think you are spiritual, but you are not. Why do you struggle? It is because whatever is inside of you will take you. How long can you walk in the things of God and not know him? You say God knows your heart and he does, but you don't know your own heart.

“Our spiritual being and all of its parts, capacities, faculties, nature, character, and attributes come from our eternal Father. Salvation is the righteous seed that births who we truly are. What is in the law of salvation? A child is conceived by right things at right times and with spiritual birth, you are birthed into Yeshua. It is his resurrection you are in. Because he got up you get to get up. Everything you are spiritually is Yeshua. You have no anointing or calling without him. It is not your anointing; it is his. You were conceived in the anointed one and his anointing.

“Everything wrong with you he died for. There is nothing wrong with you except what you choose. Your salvation began at the cross, death, and resurrection. This is where sin ends and life begins. If you are here, you are given a legal right to eternal life.

“Salvation is not about you being saved. Stop saying that because you keep it on you. Salvation actually tells you who you are based on the reality of eternity. This includes the Holy Spirit introducing us to us – our eternal spiritual being, the life source for our physical body. A baby who is born never acts like a zygote. If you are born again, why would you keep going back? If, as many say, you are a “saved sinner,” You are not born again. How can I be a sinner if he is without sin?

“See your spirit without using any religious rhetoric from the brain's memories. Do you really pay attention to what you are saying? We go to church, but say we are the church – contradictions. We do it so lightly – even the songs we sing. They make us feel good, the rhyme well, but there is no dimension. These are the things that build up the mind set.

“The brain will try to mask through religious language what is being exposed, and thus prevent us from moving forward in this season of supernatural growth in the son. God says, ‘I trust you with who I am, my name, to manifest me in the earth.’ We think it is not possible because of our inadequacies. He showed me, ‘I trust you with everything that I am because that's what redemption is.’ So why would he not trust us? “I trust you because I have sent my son.’ It is a done deal. Will you believe and live at that place?

“The brain/body uses three memory systems:

1) DNA, genetic matter, can be traced all the way back to Genesis 3 – the first man.

2) Nervous system, neuron – you have memory to know how to do things like brush your hair, tie your shoes, brush your teeth. It is having the memory of how to do things without thinking about them.

3) Protonic memory, matter

“Because these things all came before Genesis 3, that is why you think God is like your daddy, who did not treat you right. We treat God like he is like that, ‘God is ‘God is punishing me.’ You try to make God like you. If God is like you, why would you serve him? God is not like you.

“John 6:62-63, ‘What then if you should see the Son of Man ascend where he was before? It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you **are Spirit** and they **are life.**’ If this applies to the spirit life, does it not make sense to apply it to your situation? But no, they must come out of eternity and not a conference.

“We use our pre-salvation information to live a post-salvation life. If you have not learned to obey – to be a son – then you are still a bastard. ‘Your still a bastard if you have not learned to obey me.’ Your good is different than his good. What does God say? Because he is always the same.

“Only an ascended salvation partakes in life eternal (Flesh and blood shall not inherit the kingdom). You must transcend and go in the Father’s will. Ask, ‘Father, show me.’ Something in the church is broken. Something is not right. Walk in salvation to **know** his love - John 3:16. You must become selfish with that scripture – ‘God so loved me.’

“Have you experienced an ascended salvation? Is Yeshua on the throne of your heart? How can a person love someone today and divorce them tomorrow? That is not love. You must love yourself. You cannot give what you do not have. “Love is an action. God so loved the world that he **did** something. People get divorced and say it is because she does this, or he does that. Marriage is not about feelings; it’s about **doings**. Is Yeshua ascended in your life or is he where **you** put him? If you do not see him at the right hand of the Father, you are delusional.

“No matter what somebody has done to you, you must be able to say, ‘Yeshua died for that.’ You want to hold onto what people have done to you and say you are saved? Operate from broken places. Come into agreement with what happened on the cross. You cannot agree with heaven until you do. Whenever he was pierced, he corrected something in your life. Why do you sit with opinions? Let me take you to the cross. Until you go through those things, you cannot see the love. Do you really think God is like us? Think what we have turned him into, every aspect of you being linked with life. John 1:5, and darkness could not comprehend it (the light). The light becomes the light of men. You must encounter the light to have the life. What did God first say about you? What is the conversation about who you are – not in the earth, but in him? I know what he said and it will never change.

“Every aspect of your being is directly linked to the spirit of life – the light of the Spirit. Flesh and blood cannot attain true life. Why do you try to get people to love you? If they are anything like a Christian, they will love you. God said the world has enmity for him. It cannot love you.

“Only light and life can overcome the false self. The false self is blind. Awareness with everything in salvation is immersed in the life of the Spirit. If we are not in the Spirit, the only thing that shows up and shows out is flesh. The true body of Christ always honors God.

“The supernatural words of life are to separate our true spiritual being from its false concept of life in

and from the body. Only you cannot sow natural things into your spirit. You can read the Bible until you die, but you will not know God unless he reveals himself to you.

“Every particle of our being is spirit light and life. Do you want revelation? Check your humility. Yeshua said, ‘Tell no one.’ You spend all that time talking about what you did, trying to validate your self. ‘Tell no one.’ The sun rises and testifies to the greatness of who he is. We miss it because it has become common. It is the same with the moon, the trees and the mountains. We miss it because it has become common. The stars, the ocean, Hurricane Florence all testify to his greatness. It is with the thunder, the lightning, and the rain. Who sits on love and swears by himself? We don’t give credence to these things because they do not make **us** look good; they make **him** look good. Do you want to see how great you really are? Stand next to the ocean.

“Time is the realm of deception. Return. Return. Return. Would you be free to know again? Repent. Heb 4:12-13, only the word of God can separate the foolishness of who you are from who **he** is. The supernatural word is the only instrument that can “divide asunder.” The Holy Spirit through the word teaches all about the Father’s creation design of our spiritual body that is necessary so we can awaken to our destined partnerships to make manifest the kingdom of the Son on earth. It is not about how many times you have gone through the Bible, but how many times the Bible has gone through you.

“Thoughts: meaning the place of deliberation and intents means that thoughtfulness preceding action. Both words point to the fixed thinking place in the spiritual realm. Only the Holy Spirit using the supernatural words of life can truly transform and reactivate the eternal function of this thinking place. Who you are as a physical person compared to who you are as a spiritual person is facilitated by the Holy Spirit. Do you get the boxes now?

“We have been so trained by the language of the brain over thousands of years to function naturally. The expression of all life functions, good or bad, begin at the spiritual thinking place. There is a relationship between the physical body and the spiritual body and the thinking place.

“The false self can only live in a false reality. Procrastination is playing God because you think you **have** tomorrow. People don’t think about whether they will **be** here tomorrow. Procrastination is one of the highest forms of pride. ‘I’ll do it later.’ It is pride, especially when you procrastinate what God tells you to do. It is prideful to show God, ‘I don’t have to do it when you tell me to.’ God says, ‘Okay, I’ll let you stay in your religion.’

“I have an assignment for you. Get before God and ask him, ‘Where have I ceased to be in my world, and what is it in me that you would change to bring me into your world? I give you permission to take me as low as you need to.’ What is it that the enemy has accused you of?”

The more we connect with Christ, the more we live like him. But we become one with many things outside him. Look in the book of Acts at how much the church began to walk in the power of God. A direct sign of how you are connected to God is how you are growing. Sin separates us from God, so it causes division. The Bible says to renew our minds. Our flesh is not saved. Our spirits are saved not our souls. Be transformed by this renewing – metaneo (meh-tah-nah-eh-o). By the Spirit of God we can become one. We cannot get to the power of God while we are joined with things of the flesh (selfishness destroys). If our service is not rooted in love, it is selfish. If you do not have love, you do not have anything. With love, we have humility, and without love we have selfishness. Walk in the Spirit and not in the flesh.

"We have a church that does not like correction. My Bible is always correcting me. It always challenges me. Accountability is very important. Some do not want it and, therefore, are not in unity. When we submit to God we will thus form our lives – not by flesh, but by the Spirit of God. God gives us his word for our protection. 'If you keep doing this, it will hurt you. Kill sin before sin kills you. Your decisions, your choices affect not just you, but the whole body. We need each other.'"

"If not for the Father, I would not be who I am today." Brian Glass began on Friday of the 7-day revival. The white cloth is taken and hidden in the house and the middle piece of Matzo is broken in half and shared among the people in the house after the meal. Yeshua said, 'take this and eat it. It is my body.' The third cup was the cup of redemption. The Jewish brothers with Yeshua knew this was the cup of redemption. Jesus said, 'This is my blood.' Not only did God deliver (redeem) you from Egypt, but from the curse of the law. This is where you drink half of the cup. This is our heritage. The khallah (leavened bread) is the community bread (Community = ecclesia).

"Father, thank you so much for your provision and that the righteous never lack bread."

This healing to be contingent upon things, we cheapen who God is. It is not complicated. The gospel is not about God getting us out of the fire, but about being in the fire with us.

"Observing Shabbat, eating clean, the paradigm shift is because the New Covenant is about our heart. These people are God's little kids. Jesus did not come to introduce us to some doctrine, but to show us the Father. He did not come to give us

another religion, but a relationship with the Father. I boast nothing but Christ in me and him crucified. If we hold too tight to our doctrine, it becomes our God. We would deny that vehemently, but it would be true. Our doctrine would keep us from loving our brothers. It would eventually cause us to actually believe we were the only ones with the truth and despise our brothers. At the akharit hayamim (end of the age), we will see no Baptists, no Messianics, no Presbyterians, Lutherans, Methodists, or Pentecostals. No! There will only be those who are worshiping the Father. The P'rushim had the outward appearance of being obedient, but their hearts were not right. When I am around others in the body, I do not push eating clean or worshiping on Shabbat (Saturday). I push Jesus."



Mary Tate of House of Hope

"Rom 8:28, Jer 1:5, Is 63:1-3. We have our Georgia nonprofit status as of last month. There was an article in the Walton Tribune about the house. The county commissioner was talking to me and said, 'When you get your nonprofit status, come see me. It is 2018. Two means a double portion, eight means new beginning, 2 + 8 = 10, the testimony of men. 10 = 3 + 7, 3 means unity and 7 means completion. Numbers are important. They are often prophetic."

If I pray for weeks for corn and I don't get any, it is probably because I didn't plant any corn. When you don't know the word and you listen to those who don't know the word, that is what happens. The church, unfortunately, is filled with people who never read the word. My wife and I started giving and we were no longer on Get-by street; we lived on Blessing Avenue. Jesus is better than an ice cream cone on a Sunday afternoon."



Brian Glass

"When we look at pictures of those orphans and weep," Brian Glass said on day 6 of revival, "That is the Father's heart inside of us. We are the body of Christ. Brother Rick asked me to speak on unity. That is the Father's heart. When we get to heaven, there will be no Pentecostal section, no Presbyterian, no Baptist sections. I am a Messianic. I eat clean and recognize the Sabbath. When I look at those orphans, I think, what does any of that denominational stuff matter? In the Old Testament, God showed us what it was like to live without the Holy Spirit. They were walking around trying to keep the law by their own power. Eph 4:5-6, 'There is one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all.' Is my doctrine more important to me than being in unity with you? There is not a chance. Do not give the devil and opportunity. We have heard that grace is God's unmerited favor. But the truth is that it is merited because of the blood of Jesus Christ."

"I commend you all for enduring to the end, for giving your testimonies when people want to condemn you. It does not matter what color you are -black, white, or candy stripe - my brother Rick

brought all these people together, who would normally go the other way.

"Men of God are under attack too. Other people go through things as well. Stop suffering in silence. We all need at least three good people we can confide in. We have to do God's work and stop playing around. This has been the best service I've been to all year. We are all in one accord. I thank Shay Willis the minister for coming out. I thank you all for coming out." James closed the service in prayer.

That means that the next pastor/leader's Pastor Joseph: The complaints are too many for me. "What's in it for me?" Instead of asking what the alliance do for me, ask, what can I do for the alliance? When I look at the bigger picture, I see that the alliance is working. If we are all coming together better, then we can do better than we are. This is not a season for complaints, but a season for building up. What is it to serve God in America? In Ghana it is a job. Here it is easier. You can serve God and earn money too. It is difficult to serve God, but we are doing it.

Mary: If anyone has a problem with someone preaching on holiness, they have a lack of maturity. It was asked how we could justify a non-Christian organization such as the NAACP join the alliance.

Jody Bennett, secretary of the Battlefield News: The NAACP? We printed the programs and the tickets for the banquet. The NAACP does not need to **join** the alliance; we just need to stay connected.

Greg Brockman: With all the stuff in the media, folks don't trust each other. Some of us have been called racists.

Pastor Joseph: Who here is not a racist? In my country, we call it tribalism. We are all racists. Just admit it and go on. In Ghana, if some one is running for office who is from my area, I am supposed to vote for him? No! I am a racist. We are all racists. Get a t-shirt! Jesus told the Syro-Phoenician woman that it was not right to give the children's bread to the little dogs. Her daughter was still delivered. We must stop getting "offended" at everything. The only people in this country who have called me "nigger" have all been black!

Rick: I have heard so many people speak about "church hurt" – about how they would not go back to church because of it. Someone in the body of Christ hurts my little feelings at least one a week. My answer to these people who have been church hurt is, Grow up! That is life. Deal with it and do the next right thing!

Billy Angel: T-shirts! If we need a fund raiser, why can't we do a 5-K run? This happens on all kinds of holidays. We'll get lots of money for the fund raiser because what do they get is they win? A t-shirt.

Pastor Joseph: In Athens with every kind of festival, they block the streets. The homosexuals block the street with their "Gay whatever." With all the churches we cannot block the streets? Why is it that Christians cannot do this? We could stop the sale of beer and the like for it. We keep leaving these things to the government and they take over.

Jody: You are pumped up from the One Race thing at Stone Mountain.

Greg: In the New Year we need 30 days of prayer again. That tent needs to work and its falling apart. We need to take up an offering to have it repaired.

Jody: It would cost \$850.00 to sent the tent to Dothan and repair all of it - the whole thing.



Rick Hempton of Victory Deliverance Center and Founder of the WBCA

Rick: Also, if things go as they are supposed to, the 100th edition of the Battlefield News will be in April of 2019. We need to plan an event to commemorate it sometime in May.

Joseph: We should raise \$5000.00. We must step up the game a little. The alliance is not bad; it is good.



Bishop James Walker of Holy Bethel & Gethsemane FBH Churches

Bishop James Walker: This has been a tough year for us. We need advertisement for things. We had a lady stabbed 34 times. She was walking around with a punctured lung. It is vital for there to be a strong presence. We don't need gimmicks; we have power. A lady came to us yesterday who had been molested so many times she had lost her mind. So much forgiveness went on. These hideous things go on, but in God, he loves the molester too. For us to have the power and authority in this alliance and not use it is wrong.

Billy: Greg and I went to Texas last year preaching. Most times only about six people showed up, we still got through. We get discouraged, but we still need to make opportunities. We are never gonna do anything unless we believe God is gonna make it happen.

Bishop James Walker: We need an old fashioned tent revival in my neighborhood.

Pastor Joseph: We also need to stop worrying about numbers.

Pastor Billy: It's not about the numbers; it's about the facts. The more we have to deal with, the more we have to reach.

Mary: People call me **every** day. Women come to me with people trying to take their kids, their husband trying to beat them to death. I can send them to the Salvation Army, but they will charge them \$80.00, make them leave in the morning, and come back at night. Ms Mary's is a **need**; not something I just want to do. There are so many hurting out there and the church does not want to deal with them. God provides. He always does. Women come because they are in need. I came with the alliance in 2015. I love everyone, but I don't agree with everyone. Ms Mary's is a **need**, if you don't know, come and see. I take women sleeping in the woods. It is a need.

Bishop James: These people, they want change. If a demon comes in, who is supposed to cast it out? This breaks my heart.

Pastor Joseph: Mary, what can we do for you?

Mary: Pray for us a bigger house.

Rick: On 29 May there is a fund raiser for Mary here at Christ the King at 1700.

Joseph: I don't go on Face Book and not everyone has the technology.

Jody: Maybe you need more then one house.

Mary: That is a possibility. I am going to meet with

someone to see if I can get a grant. Pray that we have favor with the county commissioners and that my land lady does not kick us out. Some one could adopt one of my girls and pay just her bills until she gets a job, or send \$100.00 a month for her expenses to stay there.

Pastor Joseph: Most in the alliance are struggling, so when we come together, if we could get a little from **everybody**. Why should I come from Ghana with nothing, work and give **you** money? Somebody can work and not want to work. Why do I work? Because I like it? No! When you die, you go to the funeral home on your way to hell. But if you come to church, we may be able to keep you from it.

Pastor Billy: We need leadership meetings - a conference for all the leaders in the community done by the alliance.

It was decided that Pastors Joseph and Billy would put together a conference to be held in January or February 2019.



First Lady Sherry Angel of Kingdom Life

Sherry Angel: Ms Mary, concerning the women being there, getting them on their feet, them getting a job, etc, There are many job opportunities out there. It is a requirement for most half-way houses and the like – that they must get a job. This is your ministry. This is your heart. There are people that you hoop up with that will teach the women these things. One woman in the house can do the daycare while the others work. You are there for the spiritual part, but they must get their independence.

Mary: All my girls have jobs. They may not all be full time. DFACS makes it so hard on them. They must have certain things by a certain time. We will worship God and read the Bible. **Everyone** will do this; it is a requirement. That is why I am not under the state. State funding would change all that real quick.

Bishop James: I want to mention to all of you that there is a really good book full of sermons that is available to all of us – the Battlefield News. We can go on-line and look back at eight years of Battlefield News.



JoAnn Frey of Unity on a Mission

JoAnn Frey: We take things too personally – get our feelings hurt. Well, it is not about us. It is supposed to be for the glory of God, not for our purposes. Jesus said several times, "I must be about my Father's business." We are supposed to have the mentality of Christ. In the church we are seeing more of man's mentality, not Jesus. The basic problem is communication. Everyone seems to have their own agenda. There should be **one** agenda. If we are in the last days, we need to be reaching lost souls – bringing them into the kingdom. We want no one to go to hell. We must look at ourselves as leaders, pastors, etc.

One of the things God is working with about is comparing myself to others. It may seem like what they are doing is more important than what I am

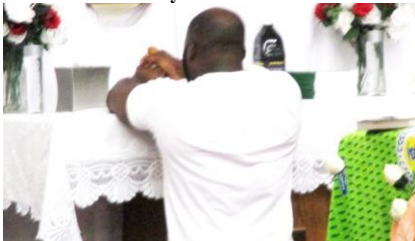

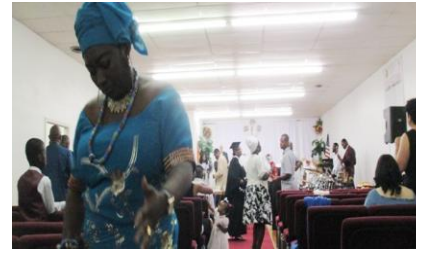

We went to church and I rededicated my life to God – I got saved. I began praying and praising God for all his blessings. I now have a job. I now hold my head up, where before I always watched the ground. I have visits with my son and I am praying for God to open the door for me to begin visiting my other son. I am not giving up. I am facing the pain head-on – the pain that I caused and the pain I did not cause. I have hope again. I believe again. I feel love and joy again. I know God has a plan for my life. He sent Ms Mary to those woods that day to help save my life and give me back the hope and faith that the devil tried to steal. The devil is a liar! I did not understand just how lost I was. Now I am found. Amazing blessings happen every single day. I will be baptized tomorrow. All glory to God for all his grace and mercy. I feel loved. I feel joy. I feel hope again. Thank you to Ms Mary and the House of Hope for showing me life was not over; it is just beginning.

Slavery and Abortion

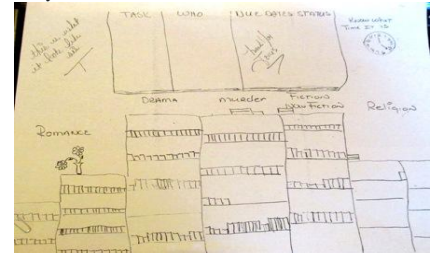

Library on a Mission

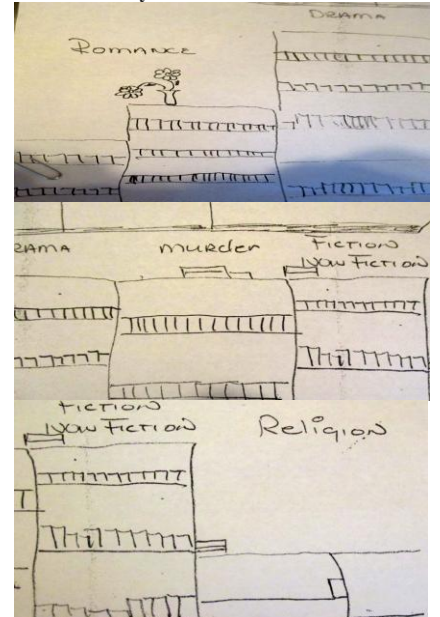

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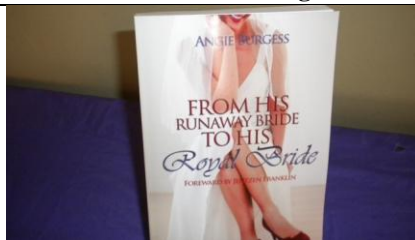

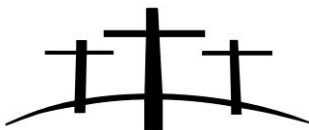
